



Blue Grove Hill 2004

A lovely wine from the 2nd harvest at Capaia winery which reveals the great promise of the terroir. The 8 months ageing in French Oak Barriques, allows the wine to show its fresh, youthful bouquet, making it very desirable and drinkable. These fine aromas of fruit and spice are fulfilled in the palate, showing the true quality found very rarely in wines in this category. The dense tannin structure is beautifully balanced with the acid and alcohol, ensuring that the wine will benefit from further aging in bottle. Despite being drinkable now, this wine will be enjoyable for at least 5 - 6 years.
